Overview

- Identify customers with electrically powered life support equipment
- Provide additional notification of scheduled outages and storm preparedness

The program does:



Allow customers to receive additional communications in advance of scheduled outages



Allow customers to receive additional communications prior to storms, including storm preparedness tips

The program does not:



Provide guaranteed avoidance of outages



Result in quicker restorations of service

Who qualifies?

Customers (or patient living at customer's premises) who use the following devices:

Infant Monitor Adult Heart Monitor Respirator

Ventilator

Oxygen Concentrator

Nebulizer CPAP

Kidney Dialysis

Suction Trach Patients

IV Pumps VAD Device Pulse Oximeters Feeding Pumps

Air Fluidized Therapy Beds

Hoyer Lifts Other

(As determined by the Licensed Healthcare Worker)



Licensed Healthcare worker has to attest that the customer (or patient living at customer's premises) is prescribed the device.

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Customers must submit a completed Medical Alert program application, including the Licensed Healthcare Worker's signature.
