# 1 Introduction

## 1.1 Purpose of this Report

The purpose of the Fugitive Dust Control Report is to document the incidents of fugitive dust and the actions taken to control any fugitive dust at Harding Street Station in 2025. This report was prepared in accordance with 40 CFR Part 257.80 7(c) Annual CCR Fugitive Dust Control Report.

Since the prior year Annual Fugitive Dust Control Report (dated December 5<sup>th</sup>, 2024), no specific measures beyond the control measures presented in the CCR Fugitive Dust Control Plan (dated October 12<sup>th</sup>, 2015) were required to control CCR fugitive dust at Harding Street Station. No citizen complaints have been recorded regarding CCR fugitive dust at HSS and no corrective measures have been taken beyond the procedures established in the CCR Fugitive Dust Control Plan.

# 2 Conclusion

AES Indiana will continue to monitor and evaluate the effectiveness of the CCR Fugitive Dust Control Plan for Harding Street Station, complete and retain CCR Fugitive Dust Monitoring Reports, and record and address citizen complaints as required by the CCR Fugitive Dust Control Plan.
