Be prepared: Each home needs an emergency storm kit with at least 72 hours of essentials. Make sure everyone in your household knows where it is.



Plan for an outage: Decide where your family will go and how you'll stay in touch. Unplug electronics before a storm hits. Have a backup plan if your special medical care requires electricity.



Respond during an outage: Report your outage online at aesindiana.com/outages or at 317-261-8111. Track your outage status on AES Indiana's outage map.



Stay safe: Report downed lines and keep everyone away. AES Indiana crews will work quickly and safely to restore your power.
