

Official Rules: Pit Crew Kid Challenge

AES Indiana x Ed Carpenter Racing

1. Sponsor

The **Pit Crew Kid Challenge** (“Contest”) is sponsored by **AES Indiana** (“Sponsor”) in collaboration with **Ed Carpenter Racing** (“Sponsor”).

2. Eligibility

- Open to children ages **[5+]** at the time of entry.
 - Contest is open to:
 - Children residing within AES Indiana’s service territory
 - One entry per child.
 - Parent or legal guardian permission is required to enter.

3. Contest Period

Entries will be accepted beginning **April 24, 2026** and ending at **May 10, 2026**. Late or incomplete entries will not be considered.

4. How to Enter

To enter the Pit Crew Kid Challenge, a parent or legal guardian must submit the following:

1. **One photo** of a race car built by the child using household items or toys
 2. **Child’s name and age**

5. Race Car Build Guidelines

- The race car must be constructed using **household items, toys, or a combination of both**.
- Examples include cardboard, recyclables, tape, markers, LEGOs®, blocks, or toy parts.
- No special materials are required.
- Adult assistance is permitted; however, the **concept and creativity should come from the child**.

→ Entries must be family-friendly and appropriate for all audiences.

6. Selection of Finalists and Winner

→ Entries will be reviewed by representatives from AES Indiana and Ed Carpenter Racing to identify a group of **finalist entries**.

→ One **Pit Crew Kid** will be **selected from the finalist entries**.

7. Prize

The selected Pit Crew Kid will receive:

- Will receive an Ed Carpenter Racing jersey +3 additional jerseys
- Meet and greet with Ed Carpenter Race Ready Monday Practice. Monday, May 18th
- Garage access Race Ready Monday Practice. Monday, May 18th
- Turn 2 suite access on Race Ready Monday Practice. Monday, May 18th
 - (at least 1 parent or legal guardian over the age of 18 must accompany the winner)

Prize details are subject to availability and scheduling.

8. Publicity Release

By entering, parent/legal guardian grants Sponsor and Ed Carpenter Racing, and their respective parent companies, affiliates, subsidiaries, advertising/promotion agencies, and their respective officers, directors, employees, and agents (collectively, the “Released Parties”) permission to use the child’s name, likeness, image, voice, and biographical information, and any submitted entry materials (including photos), for promotional, advertising, and publicity purposes in any media now known or later developed (including websites, social media posts, and public announcements), worldwide, without additional notice, approval, or compensation, except where prohibited by law.

9. Release and Limitation of Liability

By participating, parent/legal guardian agrees to release and hold harmless the Released Parties from and against any and all claims, damages, losses, liabilities, and expenses (including reasonable attorneys’ fees) arising from or related to participation in the Contest, acceptance/use/misuse of any prize, or any use of the entrant’s name, likeness, image, voice, biographical information, or entry materials as permitted herein, except to the extent caused by the Released Parties’ gross negligence or willful misconduct.

10. General Conditions

Sponsor reserves the right to disqualify any entry that Sponsor determines, in its sole discretion, violates these Official Rules or is not in the spirit of the Contest. Sponsor is not responsible for

lost, late, incomplete, inaccurate, misdirected, delayed, undelivered, or illegible entries; or for any technical, hardware, software, network, internet, email, or other malfunctions, interruptions, or errors that may limit a person's ability to participate. Sponsor reserves the right to cancel, suspend, and/or modify the Contest (or any portion of it) if any fraud, technical failure, or any other factor beyond Sponsor's reasonable control impairs the integrity or proper functioning of the Contest, as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion.

11. Entry Materials; Representations

Parent/legal guardian represents and warrants that the entry materials are original or that parent/legal guardian has obtained all necessary rights, permissions, and releases to submit the entry materials and to grant the rights set forth in these Official Rules (including, without limitation, permission from any person who appears in the photo). Entry materials may not contain content that is unlawful, defamatory, or infringing, or that violates any third-party rights. Parent/legal guardian agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Released Parties from any claims arising out of any breach of these representations.

12. Disputes; Governing Law

Except where prohibited, all issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation, and enforceability of these Official Rules, or the rights and obligations of entrants and Sponsor, shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Indiana, without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law rules. Any legal action arising out of or relating to this Contest shall be brought in the state or federal courts located in Indiana, and the parties consent to the jurisdiction of such courts.
