



AES Indiana receives Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (IURC) approval to adjust base rates

Following months of public input and review, the IURC has approved with modifications a partial settlement request to support the safe, reliable service our customers depend on, while working to balance affordability.

Why are rates changing?

This rate increase reflects the rising cost of generating and delivering electricity and the investments needed to maintain safe, reliable service for more than 530,000 customers across central Indiana.

This includes:

- 1 Rising fuel, equipment, material, and labor costs
- 2 Investments that modernize the electric grid
- 3 Customer service improvements

Even with this adjustment, AES Indiana anticipates remaining among [the lowest-cost investor-owned electric utilities in the state.](#)

How and when will this impact my bill?

For a residential customer using 1,000 kWh per month, the approved change results in an increase implemented in two phases:

- **Less than \$1 per month** beginning July 2026
- **An estimated \$8.50 per month** beginning January 2027

As part of this order, **AES Indiana will not implement another base rate increase before 2030**, providing greater predictability and stability for our customers.

What else is driving your bill this summer?

In addition to the proposed new rates, many customers see higher energy bills during the summer months. There are a few key factors that impacting your bill:

Increased fuel costs

The cost of fuel used to generate electricity changes throughout the year. Customers may have recently noticed a change on their bill related to the Fuel Adjustment Charge (FAC).

Base rate increases and FAC charges are separate and approved through different processes, and one does not replace the other.

- FAC: Reflects the actual cost of fuel used to generate electricity and is adjusted quarterly. It can go up or down and does not include profit for AES Indiana.
- Base rate: Supports long-term investments in infrastructure, reliability, and customer service

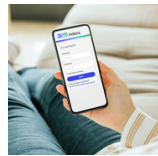
