

STANDARD CONTRACT RIDER NO. 19
INTERRUPTIBLE DEMAND RESPONSE
(Applicable to Rates CSC, HL, PL, PH, SL, SH, and SS)

AVAILABILITY:

Available to customers having interruptible demands of 100 kW or greater, who enter into a service agreement and can demonstrate the ability to reduce energy consumption in accordance with the contracted demand response program requirements. Customers desiring participation in this Rider under multiple programs will be required to have a service agreement for each program desired and may not participate in multiple programs under this Rider with the same interruptible load. Customers participating in Standard Contract Rider Nos. 14 and 17 may participate in this Rider only with load not curtailable under those Standard Contract Riders.

Aggregators of retail customers ("ARCs") may also aggregate eligible customers of any demand amount to total at least 100 kW of interruptible demand in accordance with a service agreement and participate in this Rider. Customers/ARCs must assist and coordinate with the Company to complete all Midcontinent Independent System Operator registration requirements. Participation under this Rider may not begin or continue unless MISO has accepted and approved all applicable requirements for resource participation.

The Company reserves the right to limit the total contract capacity of all customers served under this tariff as set forth in applicable MISO Business Practice Manual ("BPM").

Customers with interruptible demand greater than 150 MW are not eligible to participate in Standard Contract Rider 19. Customers with curtailable load greater than 150 MW may enter into a special agreement with terms and conditions mutually agreed upon by the Company and customer.

CREDITS:

Customer credits for service under this schedule are as follows unless modified in the written agreement between the Company and the customer:

CAPACITY CREDIT: Each month that customer is enrolled in the program, the Company will determine the amount of curtailable capacity available for potential events that could be called upon during that month. The capacity credit will be calculated based on the amount of available curtailable capacity multiplied by \$3.50 per kW.

ENERGY CREDIT: In any month where a curtailment event is called, the participating customer will receive an energy credit equivalent to \$0.10 per kWh for energy saved during the curtailment period. This will be calculated based on the expected energy that would have been used absent the curtailment event.

PENALTY: Should the customer not meet the curtailable capacity reductions specified in the service agreement reached between the Company and customer, the customer may be subject to penalties as outlined in the service agreement.

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE:

Customers participating in events will need to meet firm capacity reductions continuously over a 4-hour event period. Exceptions to a 4-hour events period will be subject to the service agreement.

Participating customers will be pre-notified of a mandatory event in line with the MISO BPM, and as specified in the service agreement between the Company and customer.

The Company will offer eligible customers the opportunity to receive service under options which provide for mandatory capacity interruptions and discretionary (energy) interruptions pursuant to a contract agreed to by the Company and the customer.

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For mandatory (capacity) interruptions, the minimum interruption requirement shall be determined in the service agreement.

Upon receipt of a request from the customer for interruptible service, the Company will provide the customer a draft service agreement containing the credits and related terms and conditions of service under which such service will be provided by the Company. If the parties reach an agreement based upon the offer provided to the customer by the Company, such written contract will be filed with the Commission. The contract shall provide full disclosure of all rates, terms and conditions of service under this tariff, and any and all agreements related thereto, subject to the designation of the terms and conditions of the contract as confidential, as set forth herein.

The Company reserves the right to test and verify the customer's ability to curtail. Any such test or verification may require actual physical interruption or curtailment, to the extent such testing or interruption is required under MISO's requirements for a load modifying resource.

CONTRACT TERMS:

The length of the agreement and the terms and conditions of service will be stated in the agreement between the Company and the customer.

CONFIDENTIALITY:

All terms and conditions of any written contract under this schedule shall be protected from disclosure as confidential, proprietary trade secrets pursuant to Indiana Code 5-14-3.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

Except as otherwise provided in the written agreement, the Company's Terms and Rules and Regulations shall apply to service under this tariff.
