





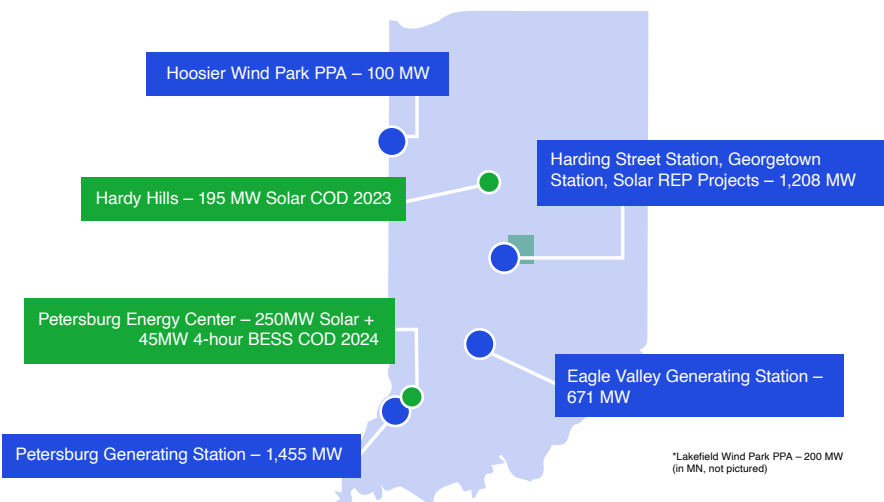
The Integrated Resource Plan (IRP) process is designed to consider various generation resource scenarios that could be used to serve AES Indiana customers. As part of the IRP process, AES Indiana is evaluating all aspects of our generation with key stakeholders to understand what the next phase of AES Indiana’s generation could look like and to ensure the most cost-effective options for our customers.

Every three years, AES Indiana submits an Integrated Resource Plan to the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (IURC) that identifies a forward-looking 20-year portfolio of generation that provides safe, reliable, and affordable electric service to our more than 512,000 customers that considers potential risks and key stakeholder input.

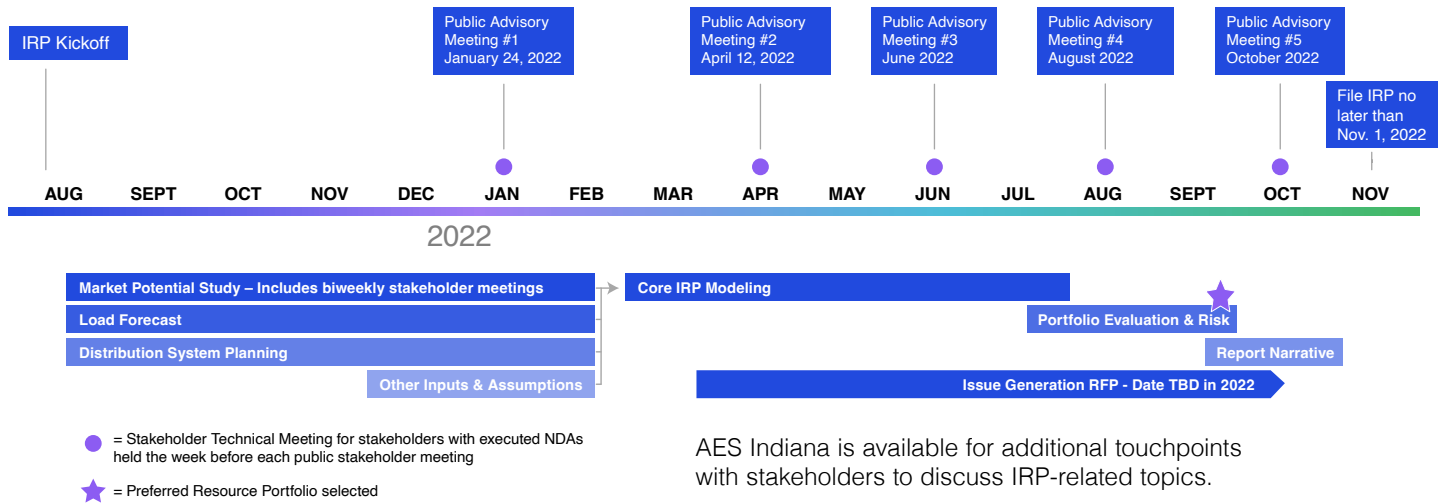

2022 Integrated Resource Plan (IRP)

The 2022 IRP process began in 2021 and will continue throughout 2022 culminating in Fall 2022 with AES Indiana’s 20-year outlook (Preferred Resource Portfolio) and short-term action plan. AES Indiana will hold five public advisory meetings during this time that will provide stakeholders with the opportunity to engage and provide input into the process.
