

Customers receive savings with elimination of utility receipts tax

While other states are increasing taxes, Indiana's utility receipts tax is being eliminated thanks to action from Indiana lawmakers with the passage of House Enrolled Act 1002. What does that mean for AES Indiana customers? A monthly savings beginning July 1, 2022. After fully implemented, AES Indiana customers will see a monthly reduction of approximately 1.4% - that's nearly \$20 annually for a typical residential customer using 1,000 kWh each month. The elimination of this tax is one of many recent actions taken by the Indiana General Assembly and Governor Holcomb during its 2022 session – and is fully supported by AES Indiana and other utilities. In total, the elimination of Indiana utilities receipts tax will save customers nearly \$250M in avoided taxes.



Manage the heat and save on energy

Summer cooling tips:



Use the air conditioning efficiently by setting your thermostat at as high a temperature as comfortably possible in the summer.



Maintain cooling systems by cleaning the filters in your window air conditioning units and clean or replace filters in central air conditioning systems. Clogged or dirty filters cause air conditioners to use more energy than necessary to keep a home cool.



Turn off the lights and use energy efficient light bulbs that give off less heat in the home.



Reduce air leakage by sealing leaks to keep cool air in the residence.



Close blinds and shades during the warmest part of the day keeps the sun's rays from heating the inside of your home.
